

Ware Choral Society Subscription Policy.

Purpose.

To support the costs of running The Society without making undue profit, but maintaining an appropriate level of contingency funds commensurate with The Society's Charitable Status.

Running Costs.

These are the costs to include the payment of appropriate fee levels to the contracted Director of Music and accompanist, or any deputies as such, and as when , needed.

Other significant costs to include the hire of rehearsal/concert venues and the fees of vocal and instrumental professionals.

Allowance also to be made for other sundry expenses, e.g.) hiring of vocal/instrumental scores.

Subscription Charges.

This is an annual fee payable at the start of each academic year,(September), and to be determined by The Trustees. The fee may be paid as a single payment before October the 1st. or by two equal payments before October the 1st. and the 1st. of March the following year.

Flexible payments for those members finding difficulty in paying the full fees in advance may be made with the discretion of the trustees.

All subscription fees paid are non-returnable.

Payment Method.

Subscriptions can be made in cash, by cheque or by bank transfer on-line to The Society's current bank account, the latter being the preferred method.

Student Discount.

A reduction of 50% of the the fee to be granted to bona-fide students who hold a valid student card and whom are in full-time education. A similar discount to be given to any member aged under 30.
